- **Prayer/Meditation Group** - We will be meeting as a group three times in September: Thursdays Mini Group on Sept 2 and 23 (6:30 p.m. – 8 p.m.; arrive 6:30 to 7 p.m.) Meditation & Lectio Divina only.
